MARCIA CROOK - Sacrificing my ability to have children for the sole purpose of entertaining the audience at the Central Gym Show in grade nine.














KELLEY DEMPSTER - Taking C. W. out on blind dates and playing chug-a-lug.

GREG DUTCHAK - Mr. Penry's long drawn out memories of his vacation and Mr. Wingert's flourescent clothing.







TERRI FONDRICK - My most memorable memories were when I had parties a and invited 2 people but 2000 came.
















BARB KIRKNESS - Being able to accomplish a foreward roll in grade 12.

JEANNIE LONG - Carrying a pillow around to sit on due to injuries.















SHELLEY TKATCH - Staying up till 5:30 in the morning thinking of reasons why I'd be home late at 2:30.










