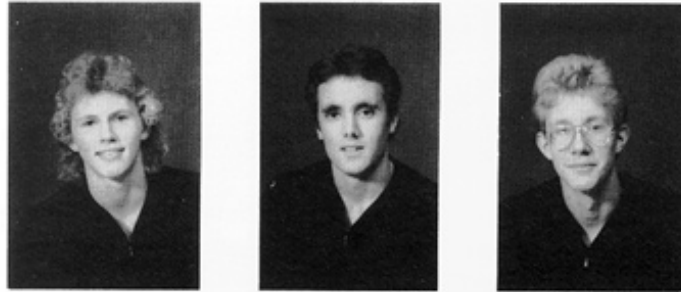


SENIOR CLASS

Darin (Fluffy) Amies - Singing into a Mr. Freezy at the Hum Along With Mooner Show over at Dr. Toothe's place.

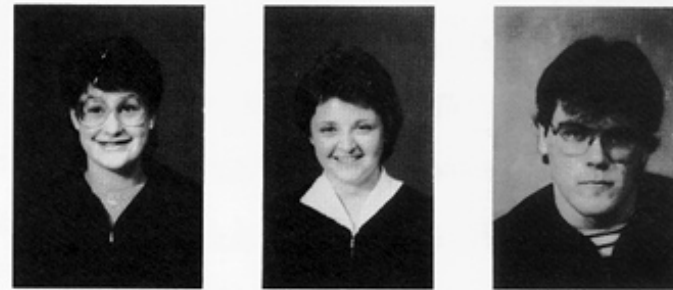
Brent (B.A.) Anderson - Fighting with an unknown female source in front of the student lounge, later coming in and finding out that the stakes were higher on her than on me.

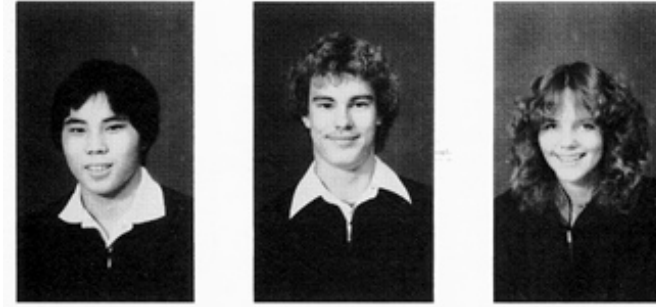
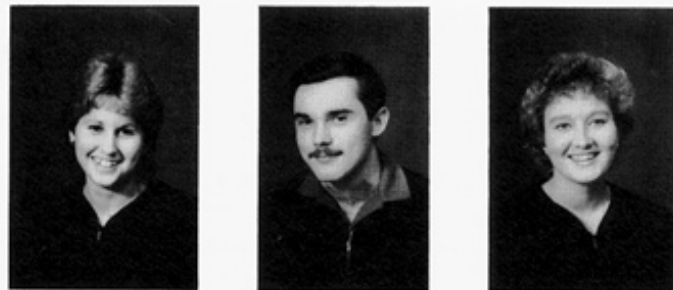
Nancy Burns - My first night out with Captain Zoolo and the outburns. Tonya pulling down Coach Green's shorts in Grade 10.

Terry (Bones) Chow - Finishing third in Provincials for volleyball and fighting in Physics class when Mr. Wingert walked in.

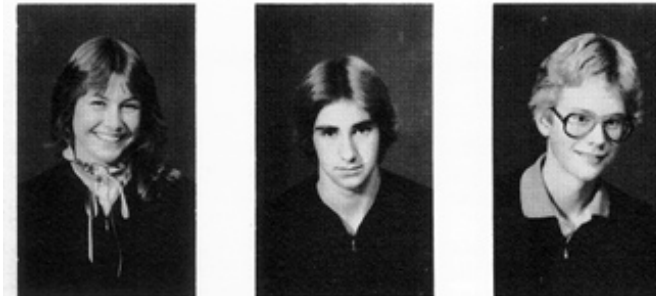

Brendan (Kinger) King - The time I left my "mark" on Central.

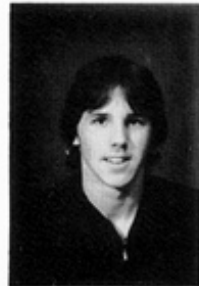

Ted (Tooth) Tilbury - Winning the cities in the last year of high school hockey. Singing Along With Mullen and Gumby.

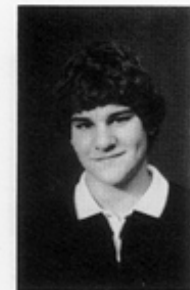
Debbie Thatch - Being sent to the office for being an accomplice to Tonya, who pulled down Coach Green's shorts in the student lounge.
