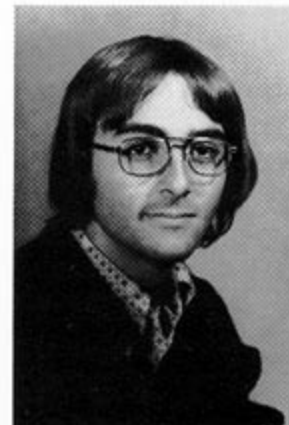


DAN HATLEY

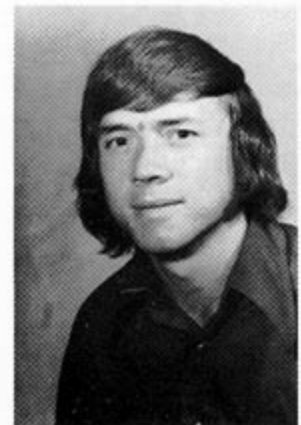


JOANN VOISEY is noted for her ear to ear smile. "Joey"'s favorite pastime is driving around in Jim's car. Her main ambition is to get married.
